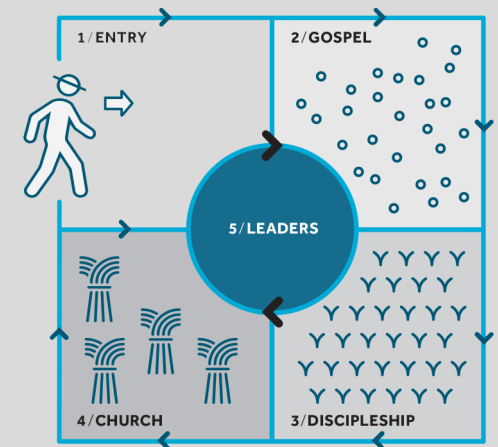

Discerning, Developing Deploying



The Ministerial Education and Guidance Team works with pastors and churches to help disciples discern God's call, develop Kingdom-expanding capacity and deploy to their harvest fields.

All disciples are called to be fruitful. Some disciples will emerge into roles of pastoral leadership.

“Leading People, Following Jesus” (LPFJ) is our pathway to develop disciple-making capacity. There are two phases to this pathway. (1) *Local Ministerial Candidate*, (LMC) followed by (2) *Conference Ministerial Candidate* (CMC).

LPFJ is implemented under the authority of a *regional MEG Team*, with the guidance of a personal *Mentor*. Each LMC and CMC develops a personalized outcome-based formation plan shaped by priorities of a disciple-making movement. Every step of LPFJ develops disciple-making capacity and helps clarify God's unique call for your life.

Ministerial Education and Guidance Services

The Acts 12:24 Churches keeps the highest level of spiritual authority close to the frontlines of ministry. A central MEG office provides *centralized oversight* to keep our work consistent, but we *distribute authority* for decision-making to regional MEG leaders who work under the guidance of a Regional Superintendent.



The Office of MEG Services and the Acts 12:24 Churches website provides a *single-point of contact* for pastoral development, pastoral credentialing and new pastors who are entering our network.

LMCs, CMCs and transferring pastors can open and update their files (provide contact information, transcripts, etc.) via Acts1224Churches.com—choosing the link for MEG.

Our office interfaces with the FMC World Ministry Center in Indianapolis about pastoral matters. Our trainees, pastors and leaders can maintain a single point of contact via Acts1224Churches.com.

Mentors



When an LMC or CMC needs to identify a Mentor, the pastors in the network serve as the pool of potential Mentors.

Pastors in the Acts 12:24 Churches are a distinctly defined and uniquely empowered servant-leadership group that cultivates and implements Jesus' call to discipleship.

Pastors “hand up” disciple-making authority to average, ordinary believers who are the building blocks of Jesus' church.

Academic Guidance

LPFJ provides a list of required training and classroom education. Our Academic Dean, Allen Wachter, is available to advise Mentors and CMCs in the academic aspect of the pastoral development journey.
